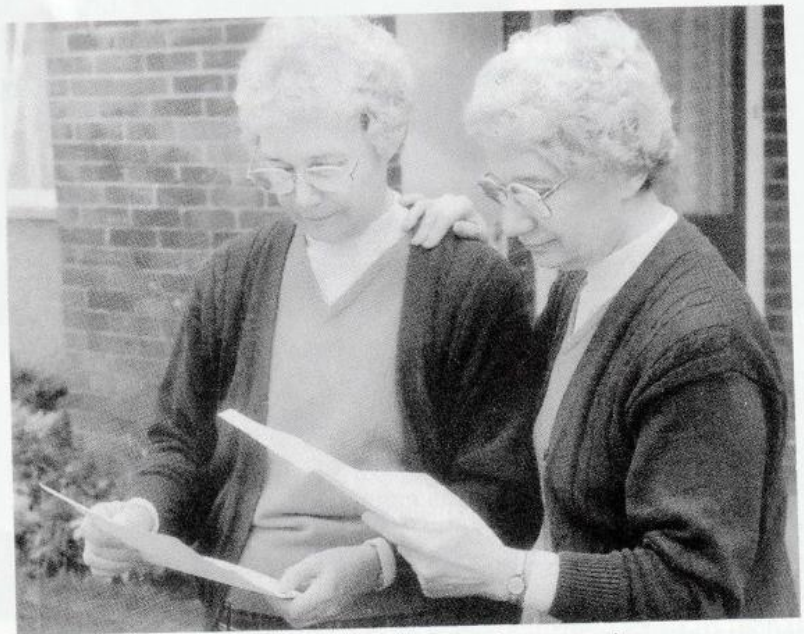


Sylvia and Cynthia Hinton
